Their signature Triquetra Logo represents the unity of 3 which embodies Horse, Rider and Saddle. Your saddle is your connection between you and your horse our design and construction is based upon.

Each saddle that they create is made to measure to not only fit the differing profiles of your horse but also the differing physical requirements of each rider.

All saddles are made with luxury leather.

Range

The Bliss of London range leans toward the competitive rider that is seeking a bespoke & very close contact feel. Saddles in this range are named Sportiva, Paramour, Liberty & Regency. They all have a Dressage, Jump and Event Saddle within each range.

The Loxley by Bliss range is a little more accessible and is a collection of Jump, Event, Hunter, Dressage,, GP & Endurance saddles. This range offers a wooden fixed & polymer adjustable tree option.



What makes Bliss different.....

Not many brands share so much detail online about their tree profile shapes. They use the the well respected Loriet Trees. The most commonly used are: Classic. Warmblood, Close Contact, Pony, Boroque & Hoop.

These trees are produced to the highest specification and tolerances within 2mm on symmetry. All trees are checked at each stage of production for conformity, safety and reliability. Lariot is now setting standards for saddle tree production and have been instrumental in moving the industry to tighter and more controlled methods.

Bliss leather and colour options really do stand out. With 4 leather colours, a range of full grain, calf and nappa options. Alongside 20 coordinating welting & stitching options.
